DEMOLITION PERMIT INFORMATION SHEET

The application needs to be completed and returned to the building inspector for a permit to be issued.

The top portion is location, owner and contractor information. The permit # and fee section will be completed when the permit is issued.

The center section requires notification and approval from various departments. All utilities need to be disconnected from the building and properly turned off and secured.

The electricity, telephone, and any alarms must be terminated and removed from the building. The Wiring Inspector will inspect, verify this is complete, and sign the application. Bill Johnston can be contacted at 978-248-9564.

Hazardous materials such as fuel oil tanks, propane tanks, ect. Need to be removed and disposed of properly. The Fire Chief will inspect, verify this is complete, and sign the application. Mercel Varney can be contacted at 978-235-5256.

If you have a private well or septic system contact the Board of Health. This needs to be inspected by the Board of Health and they will sign the application. Jim Mcrea can be reached at 978-544-3595.

If your property is within the 200 foot buffer zone of a wetland, pond or stream you need to notify the Conservation Committee. Chairman Karro Frost can be reached at home 978-544-8563.

The bottom section is required by law that you identify the disposal facility that will be receiving the debris from the project. When you have completed the application return with a workers compensation insurance affidavit completed by the contractor to the building inspector.
