Bids will be accepted until **4:30pm on Monday, April 6th, 2026** at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Town Coordinator's office. 2 identical copies must be enclosed. If the Town Hall is closed due to weather or any reason, bids will be opened and read the next business day. The Town of Warwick, who is the awarding authority, reserves the right to waive any informality in and to reject any or all bids.

1.2 Time for Bid Acceptance.

The contract will be awarded within fourteen (14) days after the bid opening. The time for bid award may be extended for up to 30 additional days in order to complete inspection, at the town's discretion.

If the Town deems the questions to change anything of substance in the requirements, an Addenda will be emailed to all bidders on record as having picked up the IFB.

1.4 Blank Form for Bid.

All bids must be upon the blank form enclosed in the IFB, state the proposed price both in words and in figures, and be signed by a person authorized to sign contracts on behalf of the bidder with their business address and place of residence.

1.5 Modification or Withdrawal of Bids.

A bidder may correct, modify or withdraw a bid by written notice received by the Town prior to the time and date set for the bid opening. Bid modifications must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly labeled "Modification – Used Vehicle Purchase: 10 ton Wheel Excavator". Each modification must be numbered in sequence and must reference the original IFB.

Bid withdrawal must be submitted in writing prior to the bid opening date and must specify the date and time of withdrawal and be marked: "Withdrawal – Used Vehicle Purchase: 10 ton Wheel Excavator".

1.6 Right to Cancel or Reject Bids.

The Town may cancel this IFB, or reject in whole or in part any and all bids, if the Town determines that the cancellation or rejection serves the best interest of the Town.

1.7 Bid Prices.

All bid prices submitted in response to this IFB must remain firm for thirty (30) days

following the bid opening.

1.8 Bid Submission Requirements.

In addition to requirements outlined in the Advertisement for Bidders, all bid submissions must include a Non-Collusion Form, Tax Compliance Certificate, Corporate Resolution, Signed Bid Pricing Sheet and complete Spec Sheet for the Equipment proposed.

1.9 Location of Equipment for Inspection

Equipment must be available for inspection within a 75 mile radius of Warwick, Massachusetts

Section 2

Purchase Description

It is the intent of these specifications to cover the furnishing and delivery to the purchaser of a complete vehicle, equipped as hereinafter specified **or equal**. **The Town of Warwick reserves the right to determine what is EQUAL.** With a view to obtaining the best results and the most acceptable vehicle, these specifications cover minimum requirements. **Components specified by brand name, model number, dimension size or capacity are meant to ensure a level of quality and performance, substitutes or alternates claimed to be equal may not be accepted by the Purchaser.** The vehicle shall meet all current codes for 10 Ton Wheel Excavators.

(4) Submission Requirements

The bid form provided herein shall be completed and returned with the appropriate "yes" or "no" marked by each numbered line item.

Or Equal submissions ("No" indicated in column) must be described in a separate document with each line # listed as provided in the bid specifications to easily refer to the substitutions. A line indicated with both the "yes" and "no" column marked shall be considered non-responsive and treated accordingly unless it is adequately explained in an accompanying document.

Each bidder shall submit their own equipment specifications, detailing their proposed vehicle including photographs.

Failure to submit detailed information where requested may result in rejection of the bid.
